UNIFORM POLICY JUNE 2018

Dear Parents and carers,

After deliberation the school governor's have decided to simplify the school uniform policy to remove the confusion of the variety of different colours that can currently be worn and also to make it look smarter. The uniform will now consist of 3 colours; **maroon, black and white,** with the only exception being that red checked dresses can be worn in the summer months. All new uniform will also be available with the new school logo on it.

I would like to reassure you that any existing uniform can be worn next year but **any new uniform bought** must follow the revised policy. Schoolwear Solutions and Just Schoolwear will be advised of the revised uniform policy too.

REVISED POLICY

White blouse or polo shirt Maroon cardigan Maroon sweatshirt (NO fleeces) Black skirt or pinafore Red checked summer dress/culottes Black trousers or shorts Black or white tights Black or white socks Plain black shoes (these also need to be sturdy, not canvas or flimsy) Religious headwear must be black

PE Kit

Black shorts, white t-shirt & plimsolls. In colder weather children can wear black tracksuit bottoms and trainers for outdoor PE sessions.

COATS

Maroon fleeces can be worn for outdoor wear but are not considered part of the school uniform and children also need a waterproof coat in case of rain.

It would be really helpful if ALL items of clothing are labelled with your child's name so we can return lost property to the right person. We have found from experience that biro tends to wash off over time, so we would recommend you check clothing regularly in case it needs relabelling.

JEWELLERY

For safety reasons only **plain** stud earrings are allowed to be worn in school and **no** other forms of jewellery. We cannot be held responsible if these should get lost. Pupils, for health and safety reasons, are **not allowed** to wear earrings during swimming and PE. As staff are not permitted to help, pupils need to be able to remove these themselves.
