Home Learning – suggested daily lessons

We hope that you have found the YouTube links and the suggested routines useful and that you have been able to explore some of the learning links that we suggested. There has been much talk in the media about online learning and there is a lot of it available at the moment (notably the [BBC Bitesize website](#) and [Oak National Academy](#)).

In addition to the suggested routines, from Wednesday 22nd April, the teachers will be providing suggested daily activities for your children to access. We are very much aware that not all children will have full access to a device where they can access online learning, so the teachers will always provide an alternative suggestion which can be written in work books or on paper or which is in the form of a game or other activity.

The website now has class pages where the weekly timetable of learning will be published, along with any linked resources. In the case of Banksy Class and Himid Class, where there are children from different year groups, there will be learning provided for both.
