

LO: To use suffixes

Adding the suffix **-ous** turns a noun into an **adjective**. It means 'full of'.

For example: Dangerous means 'full of danger'.

Spelling rules	Examples
When you add -ous to a word ending with 'e', drop the 'e', then add -ous .	Adventure becomes adventurous.
When you add -ous to a word ending in 'y', replace the 'y' with 'i', then add -ous .	Fury becomes furious.
When you add -ous to a word that ends with 'our', 'our' becomes 'or', then add -ous .	Humour becomes humorous.
