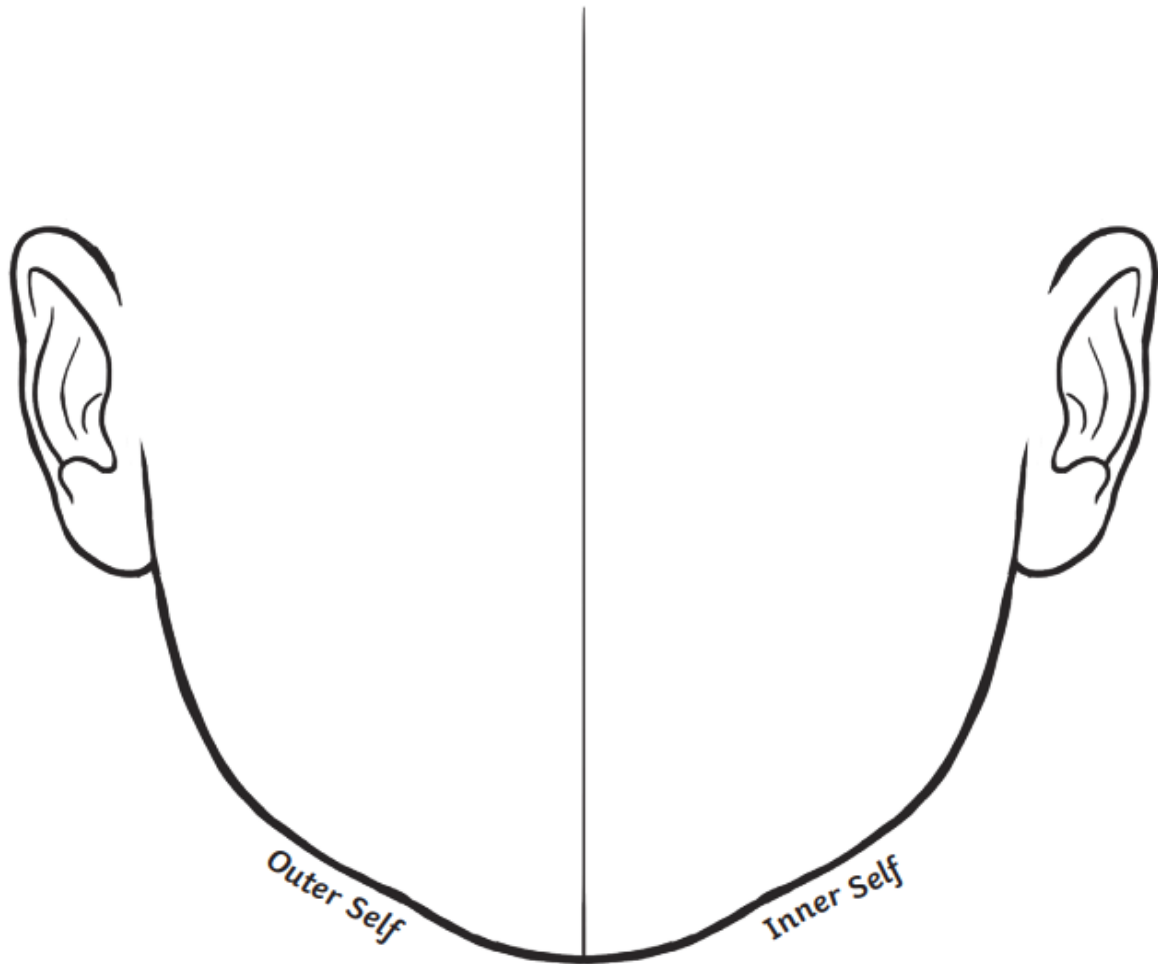


Topic 20th - 24th July

Monday 20th July: Inner and outer self

Tuesday 21st July: Self-portrait

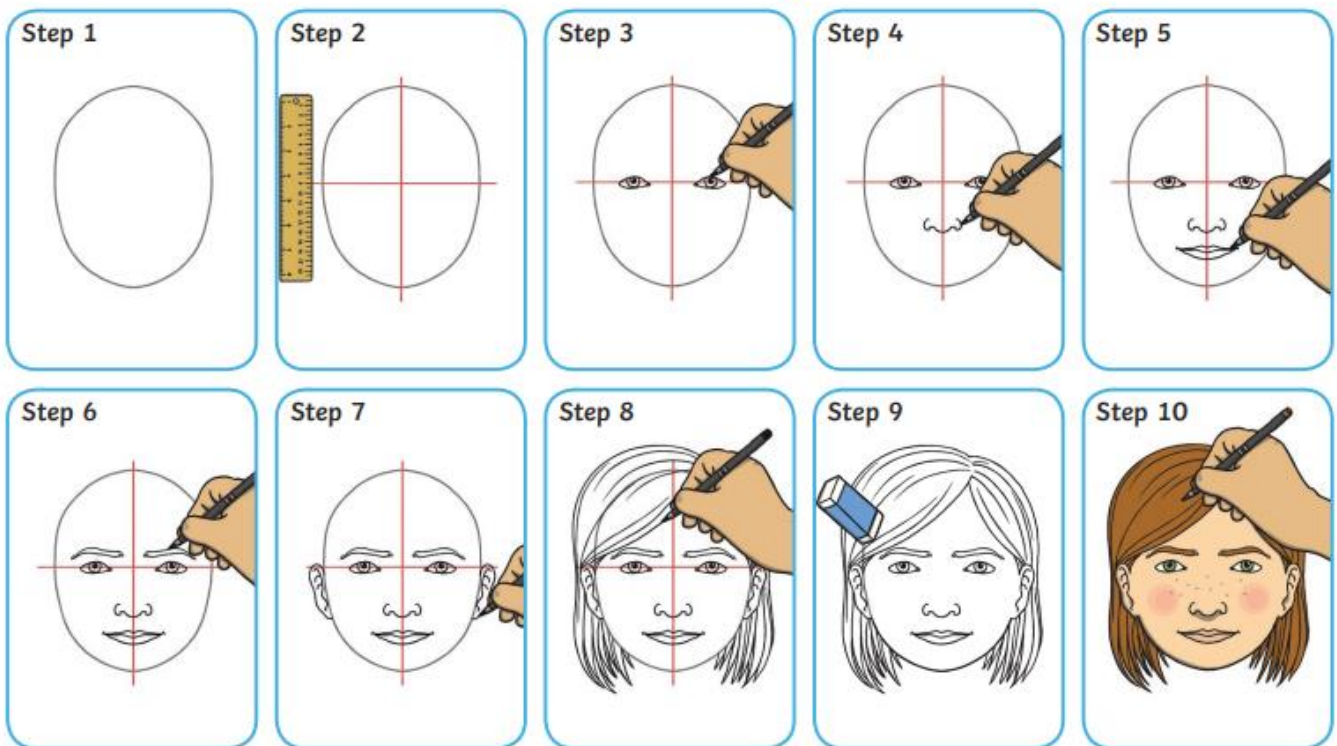
Use this step by step of how to draw a face. If you are not confident, ask someone in your family to start you off by doing steps 1 and 2 for you. This will give you a really good start. It doesn't matter if you make mistakes! It is all about practise and having a go.

Using a mirror or a picture of you so that you can look at your face, don't try and draw yourself from memory! Make sure you look at what makes your face special. Do you have freckles? Glasses? Curly hair?

Remember: Draw all your lines faintly, so if you do want to change anything, you can. If you press hard with your pencil, it is very tricky to rub those lines out.

Can you use the things you have learnt so far this week to draw people in your family? Can you draw your friends too?

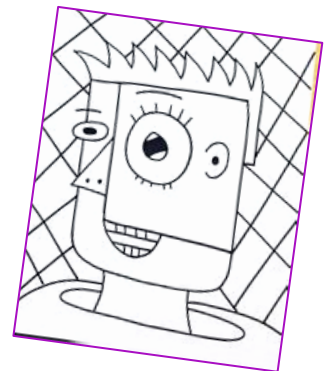
Friday 24th July: Roll a face
