GREAT and DART

Every year, our curriculum for children in Year 6 includes 'DARE' or, as it is now called 'DART'. This is special learning around supporting children in their understanding of how to make healthy lifestyle choices including being resilient against peer pressure and understanding the negative effects of alcohol and substance use. This programme is currently taking place, being delivered by Mr Eggleston.

In addition to this, our children in Years 5 and 6 will be taking part in the GREAT project. This is a course that takes place over four sessions with learning about Healthy Relationships. This learning will be delivered by external providers alongside the children's class teachers. If you have any questions that you wish to ask around this learning, please don't hesitate to ask.
